

Racy divorce ads get wheels

CHICAGO, June 8 (UPI) -- A Chicago area divorce lawyer whose billboards have been criticized by some who consider them excessively racy has moved her advertising to the sides of trucks.

Lawyer Corri Fetman, who lost her first billboard when the city of Chicago tore it down for an alleged improper permit, said she is now putting the offending images on the sides of trucks, the Chicago Sun-Times reported Friday.

The advertisements feature images of scantily clad models with the number of Fetman's firm and the phrase "Life's Short. Get a divorce."

Fetman denied claims by some critics the billboards seem to encourage people who do not plan to divorce to end their marriages.

A couple in Arlington Heights, Ill., responded to the ad campaign with a billboard of their own, which reads: "Life's short. Your marriage doesn't have to be."
